CMSgt Brian Daubert is the Senior Enlisted Leader of the Joint Personnel Recovery Agency (JPRA), headquartered in Fort Belvoir, Virginia. JPRA is a Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff Controlled Activity aligned under the Joint Staff Director for Joint Force Development (J7). JPRA leads DoD Personnel Recovery (PR) by providing strategic direction, oversight, operational support, analysis, capability development, training, and education to improve PR interoperability, enabling DoD, the interagency, and multinational partners to prevent, prepare for, and respond to isolating events.

CMSgt Daubert grew up in Ritzville, Washington and he entered active military service in September 2003 as a Survival, Evasion, Resistance and Escape (SERE) Specialist. He has served in a variety of assignments in SERE training and PR operational support. Additionally, CMSgt Daubert served as the PR Superintendent, 414th Combat Training Squadron, PR Division, leading a team to develop PR scenarios for 3 RED FLAG Live Fly Exercises per year, as well as other Exercises. Before transitioning to JPRA, he served as the US Central Command PR Functional Area Manager, 9th AF (AFCENT) Operations Directorate, Plans and Requirement Division, PR Section, assisting the CENTCOM PR OPR to fill PR C2 UTCs, advise on SERE program requirements, and future plans in support of the Isolated Person. CMSgt Daubert deployed to Joint Task Force 20, Bagram AB Afghanistan in 2019 and served as the PR Subject Matter Expert where he advanced PR planning across NATO Special Operations Command and supported the return and Post Isolation Support Activity of two civilian hostages. He and his wife, Tara, have three children, Briley (13), Kashton (12), and Sofia (9).
